





- Regional and State structures will be according to the NMO organisational structure.
- The preliminary competition will be conducted online in the first week of February 2026.
- Provision for backup candidates during the preliminary competition, based on merit, will be
 made. If the winner is unable to participate in the conference, the backup candidate will be
 eligible to participate according to the merit list.
